

Honeybee Home Blooms Sneak Peek with Such Good News

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Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Smoky Slate Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

Highland Heather Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (x2 - mats for card front and for inner liner);
Honeybee Blooms die cut wildflower

Misty Moonlight Cardstock: Honeybee Blooms die cut wildflower

Basic White Cardstock: Stitched Rectangle Die cut (sentiment); 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (inner liner)

Heart & Home DSP: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (card front); Stitched Rectangle Die cut (behind ribbon); 3" x 6" (envelope flap)



Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Stampin' Seal to adhere the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of gray woodgrain paper from the *Heart & Home DSP* on one of the 4" x 5 1/4" pieces of Highland Heather.
2. Use the next-to-smallest skinny dies in the *Stitched Rectangle Die* set to cut a piece of the Misty Moonlight paper from *Heart & Home*.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut rectangle to the card front.
4. Use Stampin' Seal to adhere a length of 3/8" *Denim Ribbon* across the card front.
5. Use the two wildflowers dies in the *Honeybee Blooms die* set to cut a Highland Heather and a Misty Moonlight flower.
6. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the flowers to the card front.
7. Tie a simple bow from Linen Thread and adhere it with a Glue Dot.
8. On a piece of Basic White stamp the *Honeybee Home* sentiment in Highland Heather.
9. Use the smallest skinny *Stitched Rectangle Die* to cut out the sentiment.
10. Use double-stacked Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the top of the ribbon and the bow.
11. Add a small Basic Gray dot from the new *Classic Matte Dots* to the sentiment and two large dots near the die cut flowers.
12. On the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the two flowers from *Honeybee Home* in Highland Heather and Misty Moonlight.
13. Add a small Basic Gray *Classic Matte Dot* near the foliage.



14. Use Stampin' Seal to adhere the panel to the second 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Highland Heather cardstock.
15. Use Stampin' Seal to adhere the panel into the Smoky Slate card base.
16. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card.
17. My Basic White Medium Envelope got the *Honeybee Home* flowers on the front in Misty Moonlight and Highland Heather...

18. Use Liquid Glue to run a thin line around the edges of the envelope flap. Lay the 3" x 6" piece of *Heart & Home DSP* over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
19. Use your Paper Snips to cut off the excess paper.
20. DONE!
