

Honeybee Home Sneak Peek Easel Fun Fold

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Crumb Cake Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 6 3/8" (card base, scored and folded at 4 1/4" on the long side); 3 1/2" x 4" (easel mechanism, scored and folded at 2" on the long side); Honeybee Blooms die cut flowers

Early Espresso Cardstock: 3 3/8" x 3 7/8" (mat for easel panel); 1 7/8" x 5 1/4" (mat for wood-grain DSP on smaller card panel); 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for inner liner); 3 3/8" x 4 3/8" (mat for fold-out panel); 3 1/2" x 4" (mat for inside sentiment panel); Honeybee Blooms die cut flowers

Gold & Rose Gold Metallic Specialty Paper (gold): Honeybee Blooms die cut flowers

Very Vanilla Card Stock: 2 1/4" scalloped Layering Circle die cut (embossed circle on front); Smallest skinny Stitched Rectangle Die cut (sentiment); 3 3/8" x 3 7/8" (inside sentiment panel)

In Good Taste DSP: 1 3/4" x 5 1/8" (wood-grain DSP on smaller card panel); 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (inner liner)

Heart & Home DSP: 3 1/4" x 3 3/4" (easel panel); 3" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Score and fold the 5 1/2" x 6 3/8" piece of Crumb Cake cardstock 4 1/4" on the long side to create the card base.
2. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 1 3/4" x 5 1/8" piece of **In Good Taste DSP** to the 1 7/8" x 5 1/4" piece of Early Espresso cardstock.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere that panel to the outside of the narrow panel on the card base.
4. Score and fold the 3 1/2" x 4" piece of Crumb Cake cardstock at 2" on the long side.
5. Use Liquid Glue on just the top half to adhere the top part of the easel mechanism to smaller panel on the card base.



6. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 3 1/4" x 3 3/4" piece of **Heart & Home DSP** on the 3 3/8" x 3 7/8" piece of Early Espresso cardstock.
7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere a new Cinnamon Cider **Heart & Home Doily** to the panel.
8. Use the 2 1/4" scalloped Circles Layering Die to cut a Very Vanilla circle.
9. Emboss the circle in the new **Hive 3D Embossing Folder**.
10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it to the doily.
11. Use the dies in the bundled **Honeybee Blooms** die set to cut a small flower from Crumb Cake cardstock and from the gold paper in the **Gold & Rose Gold Specialty Metallic Paper**. Use the larger die to cut an Early Espresso flower.
12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere them to the embossed circle.

13. Use a couple of Glue Dots to wind a figure-8 "bow" using the gold twine in the **Simply Elegant Trim** pack.
14. Stamp the sentiment from **Honeybee Home** on Very Vanilla in Early Espresso ink.
15. Cut out the sentiment with the smallest of the skinny **Stitched Rectangle Dies**.
16. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the flowers and gold trim.
17. Use a Glue Dot to add a **Bumblebee Trinket**.
18. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the bottom half of the finished panel to the bottom half of the easel mechanism.
19. Adhere the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of **In Good Taste DSP** to the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Early Espresso cardstock.
20. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside back of the card.
21. Stamp the **Honeybee Home** sentiment in Early Espresso on the 3 3/8" x 3 7/8" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock.
22. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it to the 3 1/2" x 4" piece of Early Espresso cardstock.
23. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the card, ensuring that when the card is closed you can't see the inner panel.



24. Stamp one of the bees from the **Honeybee Home** set in Early Espresso on Very Vanilla.
25. Use the matching **Honeybee Blooms** die to cut it out.
26. Color the bee with the Pale Papaya Stampin' Blends Combo.
27. Stand the easel up to determine the angle you like, then use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the bee in place so that it acts as the easel "stop".
28. Stamp several of the **Honeybee Home** bees in Early Espresso on the front of a Very Vanilla Medium Envelope.
29. Color the bees with the Pale Papaya Stampin' Blends Combo on the front.

30. Use Liquid Glue to run a thin line around the edges of the envelope flap. Lay the 3" x 6" piece of *Heart & Home DSP* over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
31. Use your Paper Snips to cut off the excess paper.
32. DONE!
