

# Grassy Grove Triple Easel Fun Fold Thank You Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Thick Basic White Cardstock: 4" x 5" (card base, scored and folded at 4 1/4")

Pale Papaya Cardstock: 4" x 12" (large easel - scored and folded at 4", 6" and 8" on the long side); 3" X 9" (Medium easel - scored and folded at 3", 4 1/2" and 6" on the long side); 2" x 6" (small easel - scored and folded at 2", 3" and 4" on the long side)

Evening Evergreen Cardstock: 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" (x2 - mats on large easel); 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" (x2 - mats on medium easel); 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" (x2 - mats on small easel); 1" x 4" (strip across bottom of card base)

Early Espresso Cardstock: Groves Die cut deer

Basic White Cardstock: Stitched So Sweetly die cut label (sentiment)

New Horizons DSP (Heart & Home DSP for video sample): 3 5/8" x 3 5/8" (x2 - on large easel); 2 5/8" x 2 5/8" (x2 - on medium easel); 1 5/8" x 1 5/8" (x2 - on small easel); 3" x 6" (envelope flap)

## Instructions for this Project:


1. On one side of the 4" x 5" piece of Thick Basic White cardstock stamp the pine tree image from *Grassy Grove* in Evening Evergreen. This is the "back" of the card.
2. Add a Brushed Brass Butterfly.



3. On the other side, use Liquid Glue to adhere the 1" x 4" piece of Evening Evergreen across the bottom of the panel - lining up the bottom edges and sides.
4. Using Pale Papaya cardstock, cut, score and fold the three easel bases:
  - a. Large: 4" x 12" - scored at 4", 6" and 8" (folded as Valley - Mountain - Valley)
  - b. Medium: 3" x 9" - scored at 3", 4 1/2" and 6" (folded as Valley - Mountain - Valley)
  - c. Small: 2" x 6" - scored at 2", 3" and 4" (folded as Valley - Mountain - Valley)
5. Use Stampin' Seal on the smaller panel (between the Mountain and second valley folds) to adhere the two parts together and create the easel.

(only to show fold direction and adhesive location)





NOTE: it's a **LOT** easier to see how to do this on the video. Fast scrub the video to about the 8 minute mark to see how to put the little easels together! :)

6. Stamp the pine trees image from the **Grassy Grove** set twice in Evening Evergreen on the 3 5/8" x 3 5/8" piece of **New Horizons DSP** square in Evening Evergreen ink.
7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the DSP square to one of the 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" piece of Evening Evergreen cardstock.
8. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the "front" of the large easel.
9. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the second 3 5/8" x 3 5/8" piece of DSP (in the "secondary" design) to the second 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" piece of Evening Evergreen cardstock.
10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere this matted panel to the "inside" of the large easel.
11. Repeat the above steps using the 2 5/8" x 2 5/8" piece of DSP and the 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" pieces of Evening Evergreen cardstock - adhering the panels to the medium easel.
12. Repeat the above steps using the 1 5/8" x 1 5/8" piece of DSP and the 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" pieces of Evening Evergreen cardstock - adhering the panels to the medium easel.
13. Use the two deer dies in the **Grove Die** set to cut one large and one small deer from Early Espresso cardstock.
14. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the larger deer to the front of the medium easel and the small one to the smallest easel.
15. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the large easel to the card base - butting the bottom edge of the panel right up against the Evening Evergreen strip.
16. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the next two easels - spaced the medium easel midway on the Evening Evergreen strip and the small easel with the bottom right at the bottom edge of the card base.



17. Stamp sentiment from *Grassy Grove* in Evening Evergreen on Basic White and cut it out with the smallest rectangle *Stitched So Sweetly* die.
18. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment to create the easel stop for the smallest easel.
19. Add some *Brushed Brass Butterflies* here and there on each of the easels!
20. Stamp the *Grassy Grove* trees in Evening Evergreen on the front of a Basic White Medium Envelope.
21. Use Liquid Glue to run a thin line around the edges of the envelope flap. Lay the 3" x 6" piece of *New Horizons DSP* over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
22. Use your Paper Snips to cut off the excess paper.
23. DONE!
