

Botanical Layers Fabulous Frames Sneak Peek Card

Orchid Oasis Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2"); 4" x 5 1/4" (card front and mat for inner liner); Stylish Shapes die cut banner (sentiment); Fabulous Frames die cut frame

Lovely Layers Vellum: Card Front (Trimmed down to 3 1/2" x 4 5/8")

Very Vanilla Cardstock: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (inner liner)



Instructions for this Project:

1. Cut one of the printed pieces of vellum from the *Lovely Layers Vellum* down to 3 1/2" x 4 5/8". The sample uses the design that looks like mountains.
2. Use the pretty floral image from *Botanical Layers* and stamp it in Versamark Ink on the vellum panel.
3. Sprinkle it with white Embossing Powder and heat the powder with a Heat Tool.
 - a. Tip: after you sprinkle the embossing powder on, secure the panel to your work surface with a few sticky notes - that will help to curb the vellum's tendency to curl/warp when you hit it with the Heat Tool.
 - b. Tip 2: do not touch the melted embossing powder until it cools - or it will smear.
4. Use Stampin' Seal along the very bottom edge of the vellum paper (keep it close to the edge so it won't show under the frame) and a couple of Glue Dots along the top edge to adhere the panel to the center of one of the 4" x 5 1/4" pieces of Orchid Oasis cardstock.
5. From a piece of Orchid Oasis cardstock, cut the large frame from the *Fabulous Frames Die* set.
6. Use mini Black Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the frame over the top of the vellum on the card front.
7. Use the corner dies in the *Fabulous Frames Die* set to cut four corners from the darkest *Brushed Metallic Cardstock* (the sample uses the filigree-embossed corner).
8. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut corners to the frame.
9. Tie a simple bow from vanilla baker's twine from the *Baker's Twine Essentials Pack*.
10. Use a Glue Dot to adhere the bow.
11. On another piece of Orchid Oasis cardstock, stamp a *Botanical Layers* sentiment in Versamark Ink, sprinkle it with white Embossing Powder and heat set it with the Heat Tool.
12. When the melted embossing powder is cool, cut it out with the next-to-largest *Stylish Shapes Dies* label die.
13. Using mini Black Stampin' Dimensionals adhere the sentiment over the card front - letting it overlap the frame.
14. Add some *Rustic Metallic Adhesive-backed Dots*.
15. On the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock, stamp the second sentiment from *Botanical Layers* in Orchid Oasis ink.
16. In two corners, stamp the foliage in stamped-off-once Orchid Oasis.
17. Add another *Rustic Metallic Adhesive-backed Dots*.



18. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the second 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Orchid Oasis cardstock.
19. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the inside of the Orchid Oasis card base.
20. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
21. Stamp the **Botanical Layers** foliage in full-strength Orchid Oasis on the front of a Very Vanilla Envelope.
22. Stamp the image twice on the envelope flap.
23. DONE!
