

Color & Contour Fresh as a Daisy Front Flap Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Pretty Peacock Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (large card base); 1 1/4" x 5 3/8" (embossed strip); 3 3/8" x 4" (x2 - mats for small card front and inner liner)

Crushed Curry Cardstock: 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" (mat for card front); 1 3/8" x 5 3/8" (mat for embossed strip); 3 1/2" x 8 1/4" (small card on front - scored and folded at 4 1/8")

Basic White Cardstock: Scalloped Contours rectangle (sentiment); 3 1/4" x 3 7/8" (inner liner)

Cheerful Daisies DSP: 4" x 5 1/4" (large card front); 3 1/4" x 3 7/8" (small card front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Pretty Peacock/Garden Green paper from the *Fresh as a Daisy DSP* on the 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" piece of Crushed Curry cardstock.
2. Emboss the 1 1/4" x 5 3/8" piece of Pretty Peacock cardstock in the splatter folder from the *Stripes & Splatters 3D Embossing Folders*.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the embossed strip to the 1 3/8" x 5 3/8" piece of Crushed Curry cardstock.
4. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted strip to the large card front.
5. Trim the Bubble Bath-backed daisies design from Fresh as a Daisy down to 3 1/4" x 3 7/8".
6. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to one of the 3 3/8" x 4" pieces of Pretty Peacock cardstock.
7. On a piece of Basic White, stamp the *Color & Contours* sentiment in Pretty Peacock ink.
8. Use the smallest *Scalloped Contours* die to cut out the sentiment.
9. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment onto the small card front.
10. Add three Brushed Brass Butterflies.
11. On the 3 1/4" x 3 7/8" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp a second *Color & Contours* sentiment in Pretty Peacock ink.
12. In the corner, stamp the *Color & Contour* flower in Bubble Bath ink.
13. Add another Brushed Brass Butterfly.



14. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the second 3 3/8" x 4" piece of Pretty Peacock cardstock.

15. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the inside of the small Crushed Curry card base.
16. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the small card front to the front of the small card base.
17. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the completed small card to the front of the large card base.
18. Stamp the **Color & Contours** flower in Bubble Bath on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
19. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
20. Lay the stamped 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **Fresh as a Daisy DSP** over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
21. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
22. DONE! 😊
