## Fresh as Cheerful Daisies Sneak Peek Birthday Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

<u>Copper Clay Cardstock</u>: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base scored and folded at 5 1/2"); Cheerful Daisies die cut foliage (x2)


<u>Crushed Curry Cardstock</u>: 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" (x2 - mat for card front and for inner liner); Cheerful Daisies die cut large flower

<u>Wild Wheat Cardstock</u>: Cheerful Daisies die cut foliage (x2); Cheerful Daisies die cut small leaves (x2)

Basic White Cardstock: Cheerful Daisies die cut small flowers (x3); 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)

<u>Countryside Inn DSP</u>: 4" × 5 1/4" (card front); 2 1/4" × 6" envelope flap)

1. Cut the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of *Fresh as a Daisy DSP* into four pieces:



- Use Liquid Glue to adhere the pieces to one of the 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" pieces of Crushed Curry cardstock - keeping the design intact.
- 3. Use the foliage die from the *Cheerful Daisies* set to cut two Copper Clay and two Wild Wheat leaves.
- 4. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the four die cut leaves to the card front.
- 5. Use the large multi-flower die in the set to cut out a Crushed Curry floral.
- 6. Use the three small flower dies to cut three flowers from Basic White cardstock.
- 7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the detailed white flowers to their corresponding flowers on the large Crushed Curry die cut.
- 8. Use the Cheerful Daisies die to cut two Wild Wheat *Cheerful Daisies* small solid leaves.
- 9. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut leaves to the BACK of the leaves on the large Crushed Curry die cut.
- 10. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the die cut to the card front.
- 11. Tie a simple bow from two pieces of white Baker's Twine and adhere it to the card front with a Glue Dot.
- 12. Stamp the *Cheerful Daisies* sentiment in Pretty Peacock on a piece of Basic White.
- 13. Use the label die from the die set to cut out the sentiment.
- 14. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere it over the bow.
- 15. Adhere three Copper Clay 2023-2025 In Color Dots.
- 16. On the 4" x 5 1/8" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the large daisy from *Cheerful Daisies* twice in Crushed Curry.

17. Stamp the flower middle in Copper Clay ink.



- 18. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the second 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" piece of Crushed Curry cardstock.
- 19. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the inside of the Copper Clay card base.
- 20. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
- 21. Stamp the *Cheerful Daisies* in Crushed Curry and Copper Clay on the front of the Basic Whtie Medium Envelope.
- 22. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
- 23.Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of *Fresh as a Daisy DSP* over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
- 24.Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper. 25.DONE! ☺
