Reach for the Stars Book Jacket Fun Fold Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

<u>Basic Black Cardstock</u>: $5 1/2" \times 7 1/4"$ (Back and end Flap piece - scored and folded at 4 1/4"); $5 1/2" \times 6 3/4"$ ("spine" and front flap piece - scored and folded at 1/2", 1 1/2", 2 1/2" and 3 1/2")

Blueberry Bushel Cardstock: $3 1/8" \times 5 3/8"$ (x2 - mats for front flap and for Inside of card); $7/8" \times 5 3/8"$ (mat for "spine"); $2 7/8" \times 5 3/8"$ (x2 - mats for "secret inside" panel and back of "secret inside" panel)


<u>Holographic Trio Specialty Paper</u>: 1/4" x 5 1/4" (x2 - on front panel); Reach for the Stars die cut stars

<u>Basic White Cardstock</u>: Stamped & Die Cut Reach for the Stars images; fussy cut sentiment on "secret inside" panel; Larger Reach for the Stars die cut "flames"

Stargazing DSP: $3 \times 5 \frac{1}{4} (x^2 - front flap)$ and Inside of card); $3/4 \times 5 \frac{31}{4} (spine)$; $2 \frac{3}{4} \times 5 \frac{1}{4} (x^2 - secret inside)$ panel and back of "secret inside" panel); Die cut planets; Smallest Reach for the Stars circle die (astronaut face mask); $2 \frac{1}{4} \times 6$ (envelope flap)


<u>Instructions for this Project</u>:

1. Score & fold the $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $7 \frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Black cardstock at $4 \frac{1}{4}$ ".



2. Score and fold the $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Basic Black cardstock at $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " - with all the score lines folded in the same direction.

Book Jacket Fun Fold "Spine" and Front 5 1/2" x 6 3/4"



- 3. Put Tear & Tape Adhesive on the 1/2" section of the second piece "Spine" and Jacket, close to the fold.
- 4. Fold and adhere back on the panel to create the "spine". TIP: The video is the best place to see how to assemble the card it starts at the **6-minute** mark if you want to skip right to that part.



5. Fold the larger piece at 4 1/4" and, with the fold on the RIGHT as you look at it, use Tear & Tape adhesive to adhere the "spine" to the left end of the panel. TIP: Once again, the video is the best place to see how to assemble the card - it starts at the 6-minute mark if you want to skip right to that part.



- 6. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the Stargazing DSP pieces on their Blueberry Bushel mats...
 - a) Front: 3 1/8" \times 5 3/8" mat with 3" \times 5 1/4" DSP
 - b) Spine: 7/8" \times 5 3/8" mat with 3/4" \times 5 1/4" DSP
 - c) Inside of Card: 3 1/8" \times 5 3/8" mat with 3" \times 5 1/4" DSP

- d) "Secret Inside" panel: 2 7/8" \times 5 3/8" mat with 2 3/4" \times 5 1/4" DSP
- e) Back of "Secret Inside" panel: 27/8" mat with 23/4" $\times 51/4$ " DSP (this will look like the front when the card is closed...it's the panel you see in the picture just above!)
- 7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere all but the matted front piece onto their respective places on the card.
- 8. Cut the following pieces:
 - a) Use the smallest **Reach for the Stars** circle die to cut a piece of dark **Stargazing DSP** with stars for the face mask of the astronaut.
 - b) Use the next two bigger circle dies to cut out two planets from the **Stargazing DSP**. The sample uses a Pumpkin Pie and a Berry Burst planet.
 - c) Use the fourth-from-smallest-circle die from the set to cut two planets from the *Stargazing DSP* one in Pumpkin Pie (for the sentiment) and one in Crushed Curry.
 - d) Use both star dies to cut out a bunch of stars from the silver *Holographic Trio Specialty Paper*.
 - e) Cut two of the larger "flame" dies from Basic White cardstock.
 - f) Stamp the shuttle image in Blueberry Bushel on a piece of Basic White cardstock and cut it out with its **Reach for the Stars** die.
 - g) Stamp the astronaut in Tuxedo Black Memento Ink on a piece of Basic White cardstock and cut it out with its **Reach for the Stars** die.
 - h) Use Paper Snips to cut out one of the smaller "Saturn" images from the **Stargazing DSP**.



- 9. Stamp **Reach for the Stars** sentiment in Blueberry Bushel ink on the larger Pumpkin Pie die cut planet.
- 10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the two $1/4" \times 5 1/4"$ strips of Berry Burst *Holographic Trio Specialty Paper* to the card front.
- 11. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut planets starting with the smallest.
- 12. Use the Light Blueberry Bushel Stampin' Blend to add color and shadowing to the die cut shuttle.
- 13. Use the Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Brush to color the inked portions of the die cut.
- 14. Use the Light and Dark Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends to color the die cut "flames"
- 15. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the larger Crushed Curry planet.
- 16. Use Liquid Glue or Stampin' Dimensionals would work, too! to adhere the shuttle over the top of the die cut planet. TIP: I used Dimensionals in the video if you want to see how that looks!
- 17. Adhere the flames in place with Liquid Glue (or the Dimensionals.



- 18. Use Liquid Glue to adhere a bunch of the *Holographic* die cut stars on the front panel and on the "spine"!
- 19. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the fussy cut Saturn on the "secret inside" panel.



- 20. Use the Light Fresh Freesia Stampin' Blend to color the creases and folds of the astronaut die cut. Tip: use the color sparingly you are highlighting, not coloring.
- 21. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut to the panel.
- 22.Use the Clear Wink of Stella Glitter Brush on the smallest **Reach for the Stars** circle die cut piece of dark **Stargazing DSP**.
- 23. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it on the astronaut die cut to create the face mask.
- 24. Stamp the sentiment in Blueberry Bushel on a piece of Basic White cardstock.
- 25. Use Paper Snips to cut out each of the words.
- 26. Use the Fresh Freesia Stampin' Write Marker to "edge" both word pieces.
- 27. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the words to the "secret" panel.
- 28. Use Liquid Glue to adhere more die cut stars.
- 29. Stamp the **Reach for the Stars** splatters image a few times in Blueberry Bushel ink and the stars in Fresh Freesia on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
- 30. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
- 31. Lay the 2 1/4" \times 6" piece of *Stargazing DSP* over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
- 32. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
