## Alphabet Perennial Painted Lavender Thank You Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

<u>Shaded Spruce Cardstock</u>: 4 1/4" × 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

<u>Fresh Freesia Cardstock</u>:  $4" \times 5 1/4"$  (mat for inner liner)

Early Espresso Cardstock: Alphabet A La Mode die cut letters (sentiment)

Basic White Cardstock: 37/8" x 51/8" (inner liner)

Painted Lavender DSP: 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (front card panel); Next-to-Largest Perennial Postage die cut (x2 - on front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

## Instructions for this Project:

- 1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the  $4" \times 5 1/4"$  piece of **Painted Lavender DSP** onto the front of the Shaded Spruce card base.
- 2. Use the next-to-largest postage stamp die in the *Perennial Postage* die to cut from the *Painted Lavender DSP* one in plaid and one flowered design.
- 3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the flowered-design die cut to the card front.
- 4. On the plaid die cut, stamp the lavender images from *Painted Lavender* in the corner twice in Highland Heather and twice in Fresh Freesia.
- 5. Stamp the small flower image a couple times in Highland Heather.
- 6. Stamp the leaves twice in stamped-off-once Shaded Spruce.
- 7. Use the Alphabet A La Mode dies to cut out Early Espresso letters.
- 8. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the letters to the plaid panel. Tip: lay the panel in place on the card front so that you know what the final angle will be.
- 9. Stamp the butterflies from *Painted Lavender* a couple of times in stamped-off-once Pretty Peacock ink.
- 10. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the panel onto the front of the card.
- 11. Add three Purple Fine Glitter Gems.
- 12. On the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the *Perennial Postage* sentiment in Early Espresso.
- 13. In the corner, stamp the *Painted Lavender* flowers and leaves in Highland Heather, Fresh Freesia and stamped-off-once Shaded Spruce (the same as on the front).
- 14. Stamp the butterflies in the stamped-off-once Pretty Peacock above the sentiment.



- 15. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Fresh Freesia cardstock.
- 16. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel into the Shaded Spruce card base.

- 17. Stamp the *Painted Lavender* flowers and leaves on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
- 18. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.

19. Lay the 2 1/4"  $\times$  6" piece of **Painted Lavender DSP** over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.

20.Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.

21. DONE! 🙂
