Hope You Know Precious Pinecones Sympathy Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

<u>Copper Clay Cardstock</u>: 4 1/4" × 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

<u>Pecan Pie Cardstock</u>: $4" \times 5 1/4"$ (x2 - bottom mats for card front and for inner liner)

<u>Mossy Meadow Cardstock</u>: 37/8" x 51/8" (x2 - middle mats for card front and inner liner); Smallest Deckled Rectangle die (sentiment)

<u>Crumb Cake Cardstock</u>: 3 3/4" x 5" (card front); Stamped & Fussy Cut Precious Pinecones (x5)

<u>Very Vanilla Cardstock</u>: 3 3/4" x 5" (inner liner)

Instructions for this Project:

- Stamp Precious Pinecones foliage onto the 3 3/4" x 5" piece of Crumb Cake cardstock.
 - a) Stamp the vein images in Garden Green or Mossy Meadow.
 - b) Clean the stamp and turn it over on the block (these are "reversible").
 - c) Use the solid side of the stamp to stamp over the vein images in stampedoff-once Old Olive ink.
 - d) Also stamp some fern-y looking leaves in Garden Green (without going back and adding the solid image over the top.




- 2. Add the little dots image several times in stamped-off-once Pecan Pie ink.
- 3. Emboss the panel in the Timber 3D Embossing Folder.
- 4. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to one of the 3 $7/8" \times 5 1/8"$ pieces of Mossy Meadow cardstock and then to one of the 4" $\times 5 1/4"$ pieces of Pecan Pie cardstock.
- 5. On another piece of Crumb Cake stamp several Precious Pinecones.
 - a) These, too, are reversible stamps so stamp the detailed side in Copper Clay or Pecan Pie inks - making a total of five pinecones)
 - b) Clean the stamp and turn it over to stamp the solid image onto all the pinecones in stamped-off-once Pecan Pie ink.
- 6. Use Paper Snips to cut out the five pinecones.

- 7. Use Liquid Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the five pinecones to the card front.
- 8. On a piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock, stamp the *Hope You Know* sentiment in Versamark Ink.
- 9. Sprinkle the sentiment with white Stampin' Emboss Powder and heat set it with the Heat Tool.
- 10. When it is cool, use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the pinecones. Tip: don't be afraid to double-stack some Dimensionals if you need to to keep everything "even".



- 11. Use a long piece of Linen Thread to tie a Double-Loop Bow (aka the "Farrah Fawcett bow"). Tip: it's easiest to just leave it on the spool and cut it when you're done.
 - a) Wrap the Linen Thread around four fingers four times.
 - b) Without cutting the thread, wrap around two fingers four times.
 - c) Pull the loops off and squeeze the loops together.
 - d) Twist the loops one time around to create a "figure 8".
 - e) Tie a second short length of Thread around the loops in the middle.
 - f) Spread the loops out to create a bow.



- 12. Use a Glue Dot to adhere the bow to the sentiment.
- 13. Add several Adhesive-back Sparkle Gems.
- 14. On the 3 3/4" x 5" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock stamp the *Hope You Know* sentiment in Copper Clay ink.
- 15. Make a sticky note mask for one of the pinecones (stamp the image on a sticky note and cut it out with scissors).
- 16. Stamp the *Precious Pinecone* in Pecan Pie ink for the detailed image and stamped-offonce Pecan Pie in the corner of the panel.
- 17. Place the sticky note mask over the top and stamp a couple pine boughs in Mossy Meadow and stamped-off-once Old Olive.
- 18. Remove the mask and stamp a third bough over the pine cone.
- 19. Stamp some stamped-off-once Pecan Pie dots.
- 20. Add three Adhesive-backed Glitter Gems near the sentiment



 21. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the second 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock and then to the second piece of 4" x 5 1/4" Pecan Pie cardstock.
22. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the double-matted panel inside the Copper Clay card base.
23. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
24. Stamp several pine boughs and dots on the front of the Very Vanilla Medium Envelope.



25.Stamp another pinecone and some dots on the envelope flap. 26.DONE! $\ensuremath{\textcircled{\sc 0}}$
