

Little Latte Love No Front Sentiment Thank You Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Lost Lagoon Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

Calypso Coral Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (x2 - mats for card front and for inner liner)

Vellum Cardstock: 5th-from-smallest Deckled Circles Die cut (behind cups)

Basic White Cardstock: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (inner liner)

A Little Latte DSP: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" card front); Die cut cups (x2); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)



Instructions for this Project:

1. Use a **Small Blending Brush** to add some **Lost Lagoon** ink to the center of the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of **A Little Latte DSP**.
2. Use **Liquid Glue**, to adhere the panel to one of the 4" x 5 1/4" pieces of **Calypso Coral** cardstock.
3. Use the 5th-from-smallest **Deckled Circles** die, to cut out a **Vellum** cardstock circle.
4. Use **Stampin' Seal** to adhere the die cut circle to the card front.
5. Use **Stampin' Seal** to adhere a length of the **Natural 3/8" Polka Dot Ribbon** over the vellum circle, in a loop-d-loop that looks kind of like a bow.
6. Use the cup die in the **Latte Love** die set to cut out two mugs from the **A Little Latte DSP**.
7. Use double-stacked **Stampin' Dimensionals**, to adhere the cups over the ribbon.
8. Add five **Adhesive-backed Cork Rounds**.
9. On the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of **Basic White** cardstock stamp the mug image from **Latte Love** in **Lost Lagoon**.
10. Use the **Light Lost Lagoon Stampin' Blend** to color the mug.
11. Stamp the heart "foam" **Latte Love** image in stamped-off-once **Pecan Pie** ink.
12. Ink just "Thanks" from the "Thanks so much" sentiment in **Early Espresso** ink and stamp it inside the cup.
13. Add a small **Adhesive-backed Cork Round**.



14. Use **Liquid Glue** to adhere the panel to the second 4" x 5 1/4" piece of **Calypso Coral** cardstock.
15. Use **Liquid Glue** to adhere the matted panel to the inside of the card base.

16. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front on the front of the card base.
17. Stamp and color the **Latte Love** mug image - this time using full-strength Pecan Pie for the "foam" on the front.
18. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
19. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **A Little Latte** DSP over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
20. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
21. DONE! ☺
