Adventurous Sky Birthday Book Fold Easel Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

<u>Copper Clay Cardstock</u>: $4 1/4" \times 11"$ (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2", 6 3/4" and 8 7/8")

Night of Navy Cardstock: $1" \times 4 \frac{1}{8}"$ (mat for book-fold DSP panel); $2" \times 4 \frac{1}{8}"$ (x2 - mats for easel DSP panels); Adventurous Sky die cut wings; $4 \frac{1}{8}" \times 4 \frac{1}{8}"$ (mat for inner liner); $1 \frac{3}{8}" \times 4 \frac{1}{8}"$ (mat for inner liner DSP strip)


<u>Smoky Slate Cardstock</u>: Adventurous Sky die cut fuselage and propeller

<u>Basic White Cardstock</u>: Adventurous Sky die cut clouds (1 small, 1 large); 3/4" \times 2 7/8" (sentiment); 4" \times 4" (inner liner); Adventurous Sky stamped and die cut cloud (easel stop)

Adventurous Sky DSP: $7/8" \times 4"$ (book-fold DSP panel); $17/8" \times 4"$ ($\times 2$ - easel DSP panels); $3/4" \times 31/4"$ (behind front sentiment); $11/4" \times 4"$ (inner liner DSP strip); $21/4" \times 6"$ (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

- 1. Score the 4 1/4" x 11" piece of Copper Clay cardstock at 5 1/2", 6 3/4" and 8 7/8".
- 2. Fold the 5 1/2" score line as a mountain ("regular") and the 6 3/4" score line in the opposite direction.



- 3. Use Liquid Glue between the $5\,1/2$ " and $6\,3/4$ " score lines to adhere the front of the card base to the back just in that $1\,1/4$ " area. This makes the "book" fold.
- 4. Fold the 8 7/8" line as a mountain to make the easel.
- 5. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 1 7/8" \times 4" piece of TOPOGRAPGHICAL map paper from the **Take to the Sky DSP** to one of the 2" \times 4 1/8" pieces of Night of Navy cardstock.
- 6. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it to the front easel panel.
- 7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the $17/8" \times 41/8"$ piece of cloudy paper from the **Take to** the **Sky DSP** to second $2" \times 41/8"$ piece of Night of Navy cardstock.
- 8. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it to the top easel panel.
- 9. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the $7/8" \times 4"$ piece of cloudy paper from the **Take to the Sky DSP** to the $1" \times 4 1/8"$ piece of Night of Navy cardstock.
- 10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it to the small book-fold panel.



- 11. Use Liquid glue to adhere the 4" \times 4" piece of Basic White cardstock on the 4 1/8" \times 4 1/8" piece of Night of Navy cardstock.
- 12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the inside of the card base.
- 13. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 1 $1/4" \times 4"$ piece of topographical **Take to the Sky DSP** on the 1 $3/8" \times 4 1/8"$ piece of Night of Navy cardstock.
- 14. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted strip to the Basic White inner liner. This is where the easel stop will go in a little bit.
- 15. To make the easel stop, stamp the large cloud image in stamped-off-once Boho Blue ink on Basic White.
- 16. Over it, stamp the sentiment in Copper Clay.
- 17. Use the large *Adventurous Sky* die to cut out the sentiment. Note: don't adhere it at this point but keep it handy for "dry fitting" the rest of the card.



- 18. Use the dies in the *Adventurous Sky* set to cut out a Smoky Slate fuselage and propeller and a Night of Navy wing.
- 19. Use Liquid Glue to assemble the plane.
- 20. Use the dies to cut out a large and a small cloud from Basic White cardstock.
- 21. Fold the card as an easel use the die cut easel stop to help figure where the easel should sit and then adhere the clouds to the top of the easel panel.
- 22. Adhere the plane over the clouds using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 23.On the $3/4" \times 27/8"$ piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp a sentiment from *Adventurous Sky* in Copper Clay ink.
- 24. Use Paper Snips to cut a diagonal end on the left side.
- 25. Use Paper Snips to cut the same diagonal end in the $3/4" \times 3 1/4"$ piece of Copper Clay paper from the **Take to the Sky DSP**.
- 26.Use Liquid Glue to adhere the DSP strip to the card front

- 27. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the sentiment over the DSP strip.
- 28. Position the easel so it's how you want it to be in "display" mode and then use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the easel stop onto the inner liner DSP strip.
- 29. Stamp the large cloud image in Boho Blue ink on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
- 30. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
- 31. Lay the 2 1/4" \times 6" piece of **Take to the Sky DSP** over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
- 32. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
- 33.DONE! ◎
