## Country Flowers \& Lace Sympathy Card

## Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Smoky Slate Cardstock: $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ (card base, scored and folded at $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ )

Mossy Meadow Cardstock: 3 1/8" $\times 4$ 3/8" (mat for DSP panels); $4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ (mat for inner liner); Country Flowers die cut full leaf

Old Olive Cardstock: Country Flowers die cut small leaves (cut 4 - makes 1 double-leaf and 2 single leaves each)

Basic White Cardstock: Country Flowers die cut flowers (2); Stamped and Die Cut pitcher on front

Country Lace DSP: 4 1/4" $\times 5$ 1/2" (card front panel); $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ( $x 2$ - cut as outlined in directions for front panels); Next-to-Largest Stylish Shapes circle die (behind art); Stylish Shapes die cut banner (sentiment); $37 / 8 " \times 5$ 1/8" (inner liner); 2 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ (envelope flap)

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the $41 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Country Lace DSP to the front of the Smoky Slate card base.
2. Cut two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ pieces of the Country Lace DSP into two pieces at the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ line on the long side. That give you two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ pieces and two $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 23 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ pieces.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the four pieces of DSP to the $31 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 43 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock - "eyeballing" the equal reveal all the way around.
4. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the panel to the card front.
5. On a piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the Country Flowers tea pot image in Misty Moonlight ink
6. Use the Petal Pink Stampin' Blends to color the image.
7. Use the coordinating Country Flowers die to cut out the tea pot.
8. Use the next-to-largest Stylish Shapes circle die to cut out a Smoky Slate circle from the Country Lace DSP.
9. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut circle to the card front.
10. Use the leaves dies in the Country Flowers set, to cut out one large leaf die cut from Mossy Meadow cardstock.
11. Use the two small leaves dies to cut Old Olive leaves. This one has two identical dies so...use them both TWICE to get a plethora of Old Olive leaves!

12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut tea pot to the Stylish Shapes circle.
13. Use Liquid Glue to adhere all but two Old Olive leaves to the card front.

14. On the same Smoky Slate design of Country Lace DSP, stamp the Country Flowers sentiment in Misty Moonlight ink.
15. Use the Stylish Shapes banner die to cut out the sentiment.
16. Use Liquid Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment to the card front.
17. Tie a Linen Thread bow and adhere it with a Glue Dot - slipping it under the end of the banner.
18. Use the flower dies in the Country Flowers set, to cut two Basic White flowers.
19. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the two flowers together.
20. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the two remaining Old Olive leaves and the stacked flower to the end of the sentiment.
21. Add a Lemon Lolly Rainbow Adhesive-backed Dot to the middle of the flower.
22.Add three small Brushed Brass Butterflies.
23.On the $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Country Lace DSP, stamp the Country Flowers sentiment in Misty Moonlight ink.
24.In each corner, stamp the little geometric image in Misty Moonlight.
25.Add one small Brushed Brass Butterfly.

22. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the 4 " $\times 5$ 1/4" piece of Mossy Meadow cardstock.
23. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the inside of the Smoky Slate card base.
24. Stamp the Country Flowers image on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope. 29. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
30.Lay the $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ piece of Country Lace DSP over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
25. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
