

Meandering Adventurous Sky Shadow Box Birthday Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Balmy Blue Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 10 1/2" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2"); 4 1/4" x 11" (shadow box mechanism, scored and folded at 1/2", 5 1/2" and 6")

Petal Pink Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front); 4" x 4 3/4" (mat for rear panel); Adventurous Sky die cut wings (x2)

Fresh Freesia Cardstock: Adventurous Sky die cut propeller and tow bar

Basic White Cardstock: 3 7/8" x 4 5/8" (rear panel)

Take to the Sky DSP: Adventurous Sky die cut fuselage (x2)

Meandering Meadows DSP: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (card front); 4" x 4 3/4" (x2 - inside panel and shadow box panel); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

NOTE: making this card will be SO much easier if you use these instructions in conjunction with the video linked above. Trust me on this!

Instructions for this Project:

1. Score the 4 1/4" x 10 1/2" at 5 1/2" and the 4 1/4" x 11" piece at 1/2", 5 1/2" and 6".
2. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of *Meandering Meadows DSP* on the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Petal Pink cardstock.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the front of the card.
4. Use the dies in the *Adventurous Sky* set to cut out three large and one medium cloud from Basic White cardstock.
5. On one of the large clouds, stamp the *Adventurous Sky* sentiment in Fresh Freesia ink.
6. Use the dies to cut out a smoky slate fuselage from *Take to the Sky DSP*, wings from Petal Pink cardstock, and a Fresh Freesia propeller.
7. Use Liquid Glue to assemble the plane.
8. Use Liquid Glue to adhere two large clouds - one with the sentiment - to the card front.
9. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the plane.
10. Slide the remaining clouds under the airplane and adhere them with Liquid Glue.
11. Cut two of the same pattern pieces of *Meandering Meadows DSP* down to 4" x 4 3/4".
12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the two panel to the shadow box mechanism - this is the 4 1/4" x 11" piece).
13. Use the largest *Stylish Shapes* circle to cut out a window from the large panel between the 1/2" x 5 1/2" score lines.



14. At this point, assemble the card - see the video, y'all - this just can't be written - at least not by this kid!



15. Die cut and assemble the back of a second *Adventurous Sky* airplane - you only need about 1 1/2" of the back of the plane.
16. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the aircraft.
17. On a piece of Basic White, stamp the second sentiment in Fresh Freesia ink.
18. Use the banner die to cut out the sentiment - then trim it down (it needs to be shorter) and use snips to cut the banner in the left end.
19. Die cut a Fresh Freesia tow bar and adhere it to the sentiment.
20. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the tow bar under the back of the plane.



21. On a piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the one of each size of *Adventurous Sky* clouds in Petal Pink ink.
22. Use the dies in the set to cut them out.
23. Use Liquid Glue to adhere two of them to the outer part of the shadow box.
24. Slide the final cloud up under the popped up departing airplane, adhering it with Liquid Glue.
25. Use the gate die from the *Garden Meadow* die set to cut out a Basic White gate.
26. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it at the bottom of the die cut circle window.



27. Add a bevy of *Adhesive-backed Dragonflies and Birds* to finish it off.
28. On the 3 7/8" x 4 5/8" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp a third sentiment from *Adventurous Sky* in Fresh Freesia ink.
29. In the corner stamp the smallest aircraft in Smoky Slate - and color it with the Light Smoky Slate and Dark Petal Pink Stampin' Blends.
30. Add another Adhesive-backed Bird.



31. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Petal Pink cardstock.

32. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the back of the card.
33. Stamp and color the *Adventurous Sky* airplane on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
34. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
35. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of *Meandering Meadows 6" x 6" DSP* over the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
36. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
37. DONE! ☺
