

Bright & Beautiful Flying By Hello Card

[Card Stock Cuts for this Project:](#)

[Azure Afternoon Cardstock:](#) 4 1/4" x 11" (card base - scored and folded at 5 1/2")

[Basic White Cardstock:](#) 3 5/8" x 4 7/8" (behind raised DSP panel on front); Stamped & fussy cut paper airplanes (x3); 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)

[Bright & Beautiful 6" x 6" DSP:](#) 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (front card panel); 3 3/4" x 5" (card front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" piece of star-strewn **Bright & Beautiful 6" x 6" DSP** to the front of the Azure Afternoon card base.
2. Use the next-to-smallest square **Stylish Shapes** die cut three windows in the 3 3/4" x 5" piece of **Bright & Beautiful 6" x 6" DSP**.
3. Place the 3 5/8" x 4 7/8" piece of Basic White cardstock behind the DSP panel and use a pencil to lightly outline where the windows will be on the white panel.
4. Use the two cloud images in the **Flying By** set to stamp Balmy Blue clouds onto the Basic White cardstock, placing a couple of clouds "in" each window.
5. Set the DSP panel back in place on the white cardstock and stamp the **Flying By** "hello" sentiment in Blueberry Bushel ink, ensuring that part of the "flight-path" is inside the window.
6. Erase all the pencil lines and use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the DSP panel over the Basic White panel.
7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the front of the card base.
8. On a piece of Basic White cardstock stamp three paper airplanes from **Flying By** in Tuxedo Black Memento Ink.
9. Use Paper Snips to cut out the three planes.
10. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere a plane into each window. Note: Make sure that the middle plane is aligned with the stamped "flight-path".
11. Add five **Adhesive-backed Dots for Days**.
12. On the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock stamp a few paper planes in Tuxedo Black Memento Ink and clouds in Balmy Blue ink.
13. Use the bullet-tip of the Blueberry Bushel Stampin' Write Marker to add free-hand "flight-paths".



14. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Azure Afternoon card base.

15. Stamp the **Flying By** paper airplane and clouds and add a freehand "flight-path" on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
16. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
17. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **Bright & Beautiful 6" x 6" DSP** on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
18. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
19. DONE! ☺
