

Snowy Sweetest Star Christmas Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Pecan Pie Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" (card base, scored & folded at 5 1/2"); Stamped and punched Sweetest Star starman

Real Red Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front); 1 1/4" x 5" (mat for DSP strip on front)

Basic White Cardstock: 1/2" x 1 5/8" (sentiment); 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)

Snowy Scenes DSP: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (card front); 1 1/8" x 4 3/4" (DSP strip on front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of pink snowflake paper from the **Snowy Scenes DSP** onto the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Real Red cardstock.
2. Use the Paper Trimmer to cut the 1 1/8" x 4 3/4" piece of candy-cane paper from the **Snowy Scenes DSP** on an angle.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the two pieces onto the 1 1/4" x 5" piece of Real Red cardstock.
4. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted strip to the card front.
5. Tie a simple bow from two lengths of **Real Red & White Baker's Twine** and adhere it to the DSP strip with a Glue Dot.
6. On a piece of Pecan Pie cardstock, stamp the **Sweetest Star** gingerbread-starman in Versamark Ink, sprinkle it with white Embossing Powder and heat set it with the Heat Tool.
7. When the image is cool, use the **Simply Scored Scoring Tool** to score from each point - to the center. And then score from each "valley" (between the points) to the center.
8. Fold the point-score lines as mountains and the valley-score lines as valleys.



9. Add three small Real Red & White Adhesive-backed Peppermints for "buttons".
10. Use double-stacked Stampin' Dimensionals at the center of the star to adhere it over the bow.
11. On the 1/2" x 1 5/8" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the **Sweetest Star** sentiment in Pecan Pie ink.
12. Use Stampin' Dimensionals (single on the left side and double-stacked on the right) to adhere it to the card front.
13. Use small dots of Liquid Glue to adhere five **White Loose Snowflakes!**
14. In the bottom left and top right corners of the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock stamp the snowflakes image from **Sweetest Star** in Petal Pink ink.
15. Stamp the sentiment in Pecan Pie ink.



16. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Pecan Pie card base.
17. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
18. Stamp the Petal Pink snowflakes on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
19. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
20. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **Snowy Scenes DSP** on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
21. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
22. DONE!
