

# Wildflower Birthday Celebration Sneak Peek Cards

**Card Stock Cuts for this Project:**

**Pretty in Pink or Peach Pie Card Stock:** 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

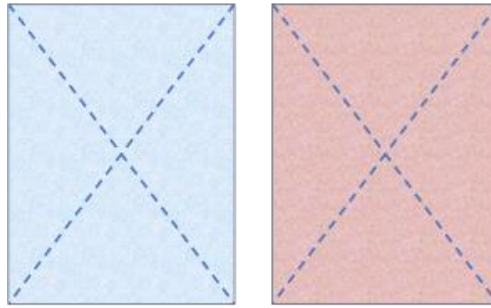
**Soft Sea Foam Cardstock:** 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front)

**Basic White Cardstock:** About 3 1/2" x 4" (stamped panel behind card front); 4" x 5 1/4" (x2 - card front and inner liner); Perennial Postage die cut (sentiment)

**Wildflower Birthday Specialty DSP:** 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (x 2 per card - cut into four triangles); Birthday Celebration die cut banner (one per card); Die cuts on each card; 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

## Instructions for this Project:

1. Stack two 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" pieces of the **Wildflower Birthday Specialty DSP** (making sure they're all lined up) and then use the Paper Trimmer to cut both pieces from corner to corner.
2. Keeping them completely stacked and lined up with each other, rotate them within the Trimmer and cut them on the diagonal the other way. Note: you can check the video to see how to do this.



3. The result is four triangles cut from both panels - making eight total triangles. Each two panels - cut into eight triangles - makes two card fronts.



4. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the triangles to the 4" x 5 1/4" pieces of Soft Sea Foam cardstock - mixing the designs - butting up the cut edges and eyeballing a "normal" reveal all the way around the mat.
5. Use the large banner die from **Birthday Celebration** to cut one banner for each card front from a piece of Soft Sea Foam **Wildflower Birthday Specialty DSP**.
6. For one of the card designs stamp the banner with the **Birthday Celebration** sentiment in Blueberry Bushel ink.
7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the banner to each of the card fronts.
8. For the first design, adhere a die cut balloon (from the **Wildflower Birthday Specialty DSP**) - with Stampin' Dimensionals under the balloon - and Liquid Glue on the string.
9. Adhere the small floral arrangement to the string with Dimensionals. Note: the wrapper on the cupcake matches the flowers on the balloon and the card base).
10. Adhere the die cut cupcake, flowers and leaves using a combination of Liquid Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.



11. For the second card design, stamp the sentiment in Blueberry Bushel ink, on the 1 1/8" x 1 7/8" piece of Basic White cardstock.
12. Use the larger of the two small banner dies in the **Birthday Celebration** die set to cut out two small Basic White banner die cuts for each card front.
13. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the cake die cut (from the DSP).
14. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the two small Basic White banners.

15. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere and sentiment over the banners. Note if you want to see how to assemble the banner check out the video.



16. Adhere the flowers and leaves with Liquid Glue or Stampin' Dimensionals.  
17. Add five **Party Dots** - in Peach Pie or Pretty in Pink - to each card front.  
18. To make the inside of the cards, stamp the **Birthday Celebration** word "birthday" in Blueberry Bushel on the 4" x 5 1/4" pieces of Basic White cardstock.  
19. Stamp the word "happy" above it.  
20. Stamp the small stem from the set in Old Olive ink and then stamp the flower - in Peach Pie or Pretty in Pink (to match the card base).



21. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the card bases.  
22. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card fronts to the front of the card bases.  
23. My Basic White Medium Envelopes got the **Birthday Celebration** flowers on the front - with the flowers stamped to match the card bases.  
24. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.

25. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of *Wildflower Birthday Specialty DSP* on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
26. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
27. DONE!
