

# Lovely Year of Flowers Sneak Peek Birthday Card

**Thick Basic White Cardstock:** 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" (card base, scored & folded at 4 1/4")

**Daffodil Delight Cardstock:** 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front)

**Basic White Cardstock:** 3 1/4" x 4 1/2" (corrugated front panel); Year of Flowers label die cuts (x3); Year of Flowers die cut leaves (x5); Smallest Textured Notes die cut rectangle (sentiment) ; 4" x 5 1/4" inner liner)

**Lovely Garden DSP:** 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (card front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

## Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of *Lovely Garden DSP* on the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Daffodil Delight cardstock.
2. Emboss the 3 1/4" x 5 1/2" panel of Basic White cardstock in the *Mini Corrugated 3D Embossing Folder*.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the embossed panel to the card front.
4. Use the three foliage dies in the *Year of Flowers* die set to cut out five Basic White leaves - 2 each of the two larger leaves, 2 each of the medium leaves and one of the smallest leaf.
5. Use Liquid Glue to adhere three leaves (one leaf in each size) to the top right corner of the Corrugated panel and the remaining two leaves (one large and one medium) in the bottom left corner.
6. On a piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp three of the flower images from the *Year of Flowers* set in Garden Green ink.
7. Using Garden Green, Daffodil Delight (March), Fresh Freesia (May) and Melon Mambo (April) Watercolor Pencils to color the images.



8. Use the label die in the *Year of Flowers* die set to cut out the three flowers.
9. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere them to the Corrugated panel. Tip: center the middle die cut and adhere it first - then add the two outer die cuts. That'll help get them evenly spaced.
10. On a piece of Basic White cardstock stamp the *Year of Flowers* sentiment in Garden Green ink.
11. Use the smallest die in the *Textured Notes* die set to cut out the sentiment.
12. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment at the bottom of the Corrugated panel.
13. Add three Fresh Freesia embellishments from the *Starburst Sequins*.
14. On the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock stamp the second sentiment from the *Year of Flowers* set in Garden Green ink.
15. In the corner stamp another of the *Year of Flowers* flowers in Garden Green ink.
16. Color the flower with the Watercolor Pencils.

17. Add a Fresh Freesia **Starburst Sequin**.



18. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Thick Basic White card base.
19. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
20. Stamp and color a **Year of Flowers** flower on the front of the Basix White Medium Envelope.
21. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
22. Lay a 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **Lovely Garden DSP** on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
23. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
24. DONE!
