

# Sailing at Sunrise Congratulations Card

**Card Stock Cuts for this Project:**

**Fresh Freesia Cardstock:** 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

**Smoky Slate Cardstock:** 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front ); Sunrise Sailing die cut seagulls

**Basic White Cardstock:** 4 1/4" x 5 1/2"  
(Card front - colored and cut down to 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"); Sunrise Sailing die cut sailboat; 1/2" x 3 3/8" (sentiment); 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner )

## Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Small Blending Brushes to add color to the 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" piece of Basic White cardstock. Put Fresh Freesia in the top portion - about 1/3 of the way down - Pretty in Pink below that - and Balmy Blue on the bottom portion.
2. When finished, use a Paper Trimmer to cut the panel down to 3 7/8" x 5 1/8".
3. Emboss the panel in the ***Sunrise Sailing Hybrid Embossing Folder*** - placing the ocean part of the folder on the Balmy Blue section of the panel.
4. Once it's embossed add some more Balmy Blue over the waves - just to add a little depth.
5. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Smoky Slate cardstock.
6. On a piece of Basic White cardstock stamp the ***Sunrise Sailing*** sailboat image in Balmy Blue ink.
7. Stamp the hull image in Balmy Blue ink.
8. Stamp the sails detail in Fresh Freesia ink.
9. Use the die in the ***Sunrise Sailing*** die set to cut out the sailboat.
10. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the die cut sailboat over the embossed sailboat on the card front.
11. On the 1/2" x 3 3/8" strip of Basic White cardstock stamp the ***Sunrise Sailing*** sentiment in Balmy Blue ink.
12. Use Paper Snips to snip a banner in the right end of the strip.
13. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment to the card front.
14. Use the ***Sunrise Sailing*** die to cut out three Smoky Slate birds.
15. Use little dabs of Liquid Glue to adhere them to the card front.
16. Across the bottom of the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp the ***Sunrise Sailing*** watery waves image in Balmy Blue ink.
17. Stamp the sailboat in Balmy Blue and the sails image in Fresh Freesia ink.
18. Add a Fresh Freesia seagull near the front of the boat.



19. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Fresh Freesia card base.
20. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of card base.
21. Stamp the ***Sunrise Sailing*** boat, waves and bird images on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
22. Stamp the ***Sunrise Sailing*** waves and bird images on the envelope flap.
