

# Masculine Prairie Grass Healing Power Card

**Card Stock Cuts for this Project:**

**Crumb Cake Cardstock:** 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2"); 4" x 5 1/4" (x2 - card front and inner liner); Next-to-Smallest Stylish Shapes square die (sentiment)



## Instructions for this Project:

1. Stamp the large grass image from the *Prairie Grass* set in Early Espresso ink on one of the 4" x 5 1/4" pieces of Crumb card cardstock.
2. Set the next-to-largest **Textured Notes** die in place and use the bullet end of the Early Espresso Stampin' Write Marker to trace the rectangle onto the card stock.
3. Use the Marker to add a few little cross-marks at each corner and on the one side.
4. Emboss the panel in the **Exposed Brick 3D Embossing Folder**.
5. On a piece of Crumb Cake cardstock stamp the *Prairie Grass* sentiment in Early Espresso ink.
6. Place the next-to-smallest square **Stylish Shapes** die over the sentiment - tipped up to be a diamond - and cut out the sentiment. to cut it out.
7. Tie a simple bow from two lengths of **Linen Thread** and adhere it with a little Liquid Glue.
8. Use double-stacked Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the top of the bow.
9. Add three **Pressed Flower Motifs** embellishments.
10. In the corner of the remaining 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Crumb Cake cardstock, stamp the cattails image from the *Prairie Grass* set in Early Espresso ink.
11. Use the next-to-largest **Textured Notes** die and the Early Espresso Stampin' Write Marker to add the framing.



12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel inside the Crumb Cake card base.
13. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
14. Stamp the smallest grasses image from the *Prairie Grass* set and add a partial frame Early Espresso on the front on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
15. Stamp the cattails from *Prairie Grass* in Early Espresso ink a few times on the envelope flap.
