## Sweet Cute as a Bug Sneak Peek Hello Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

<u>Poppy Parade Cardstock</u>:  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x 11" (card base, scored and folded at  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ ")

<u>Basic White Cardstock</u>: Largest Stylish Shapes circle die cut (sentiment);  $4" \times 5 \frac{1}{4}"$  (inside liner)

<u>Cute As a Bug DSP</u>:  $41/4" \times 51/2"$  (card front panel); Largest Stylish Shapes square die cut (on card front); Die cut caterpillar, bee and flower on front;  $21/4" \times 6"$  (envelope flap)

## Instructions for this Project:

- 1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the  $4 \frac{1}{4}$ " x  $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " piece of the *Cute As a Bug DSP* to the front of the Poppy Parade card base.
- 2. Use the largest square **Stylish Shapes** die to cut out a piece of fruity **Cute As a Bug DSP**.
- 3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the square to the card front.
- 4. Use the largest Stylish Shapes circle die to cut out a Basic White circle.
- 5. Carefully ink just the word "hello" on the *Sweetest Bugs* stamp in Poppy Parade ink and stamp it on the circle.
- 6. Underneath the sentiment, stamp the double-line image from the set twice (next to each other so it will go all the way across the circle) in Crushed Curry ink.
- 7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the circle to the card front.
- 8. Use the dies from the *Sweetest Bugs* set to cut out a Blackberry Bliss caterpillar (carrying a leaf umbrella), a bee, and a single flower all from a piece of the *Cute As a Bug DSP*.
- 9. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the caterpillar and the bee to the Basic White circle.
- 10. Slide the die cut flower up under the bees hands and adhere it with Liquid Glue.
- 11. Add three Ladybug Garden Epoxy Shapes.
- 12. In the top right corner of the  $4" \times 5 \frac{1}{4}"$  piece of Basic White cardstock stamp the bee and the single flower image from **Sweetest Bugs** in Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
- 13. Color the bee body with the Crushed Curry Stampin' Write Marker. Color around his neck with the Dark Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blend. Color his head with the Light Smoky Slate Stampin' Blend. Color the flower petals with the Light Daffodil Delight Blend.



- 14. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Poppy Parade card base.
- 15. Stamp and color the bee and flower from *Sweetest Bugs* on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
- 16. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
- 17. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of *Cute As a Bug DSP* to the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
- 18. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
- 19. DONE!
