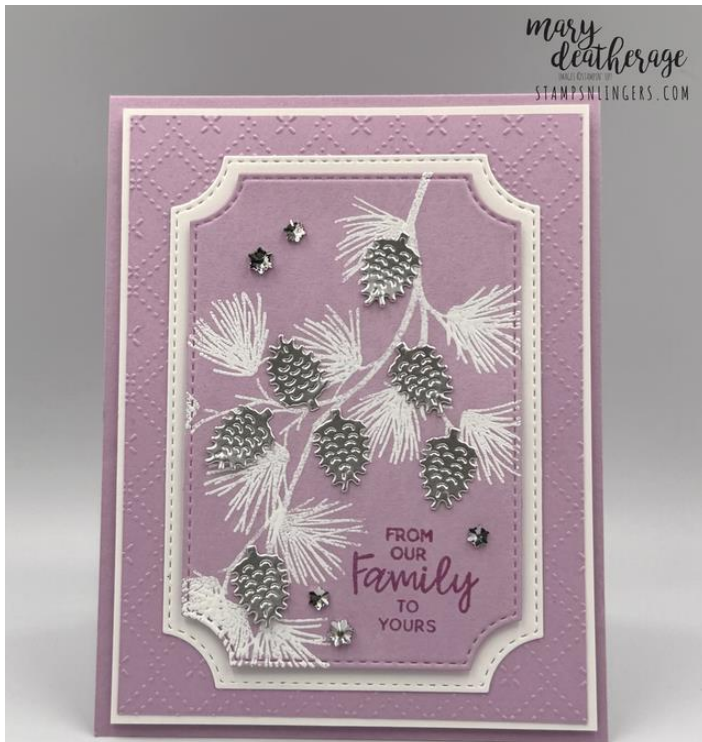


# Traditional Labels Branching Out Christmas Card

**Card Stock Cuts for this Project:**

**Fresh Freesia Cardstock:** 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2"); 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (embossed card front); Next-to-Largest Branching Out die (sentiment panel)

**Silver Foil Sheets:** Branching Out die cut pine cones (x7)

**Basic White Cardstock:** 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front); Second-from-Largest Branching Out die (mat for sentiment panel); 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)



## Instructions for this Project:

1. Embossing the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of Fresh Freesia cardstock in the **Beautiful Pattern 3D Embossing Folder**.
2. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock.
3. Use the second-to- largest **Branching Out** die to cut out a Fresh Freesia panel.
4. Rub it well with the Embossing Buddy and then stampe the large branch from the **Branching Out** set in Versamark Ink.
5. Sprinkle it with white **Basics WOW! Embossing Powder** and heat set it with the Heat Tool.
6. Down in the corner stamp the sentiment from **Branching Out** in Petunia Pop ink.
7. Rub the panel again with the Embossing Buddy and stamp some pine fronds in Versamark Ink, sprinkle them with the white embossing powder and heat set them
8. After it's all cool, repeat the Emboss Buddy/Stamp/Sprinkle/Heat Set process a couple more times until you have it as frond-y as you like!
9. Use the pine cone die in the **Branching Out** bundle to cut out seven **Silver Foil** pinecones.
10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere them to the card front.
11. Use the next largest **Branching Out** die (so - the next-to-largest die) to cut out a Basic White mat.
12. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the embossed panel to the mat,
13. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the whole thing to the card front.
14. Add five clear **Faceted Snowflakes**.
15. On the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock, stamp two word sentiments from the Traditional Labels set in Petunia Pop ink.
16. In the corner stamp more **Branching Out** pine images in Fresh Freesia.



17. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Fresh Freesia card base.
18. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
19. Stamp **Branching Out** pine images in Fresh Freesia on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
20. Stamp **Branching Out** pine images in Fresh Freesia on the envelope flap.
21. DONE!
