## Gears & Textures Reason to Celebrate Sneak Peek Birthday Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

<u>Smoky Slate Cardstock</u>: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2"); Stylish Shapes banner (sentiment)

<u>Secret Sea Cardstock</u>: 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front); Gears & Textures die cut light bulb backs (x2)

<u>Earthen Toned Metallic Specialty Paper</u>: <u>Gears & Textures die cut gears and parts</u>

<u>Textured Metallic Specialty Paper (in</u>
<u>Copper & Tungsten)</u>: Gears & Textures die
cut gears and parts

<u>Basic White Cardstock</u>: Gears & Textures stamped & die cut light bulbs and gears; 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)

<u>Square Snippets DSP</u>:  $37/8" \times 518"$  (card front);  $21/4" \times 6"$  (envelope flap)

## Instructions for this Project:

1. Use a few of the images in the *Gears & Textures* stamp set to stamp the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of *Square Snippets DSP* in stamped-off-once and stamped-off-twice Secret Sea ink.



- 2. On a piece of Basic White cardstock stamp the light-bulb filament image from *Gears*& *Textures* twice in Secret Sea ink.
- 3. Also stamp a few gears in Smoky Slate ink.
- 4. Use the coordinating dies in the Gear & Textures die set to cut everything out.
- 5. Use the die in the set to cut out two of the lightbulb-element die cuts in Secret Sea cardstock.
- 6. Use Liquid Glue to adhere each of the die cut light-bulb filaments to the two Secret Sea lightbulb-elements.
- 7. Use the dies in the set to cut out a bunch of gears and elements from a combination of Copper & Tungsten (this is the dark gray color) Textured Metallic Specialty Paper and Earthen Toned Metallic Specialty Paper. The video linked above shows you all the elements I used on this sample card but...have fun with the dies! There's no right or wrong here you just want a large gear, a couple of mediums, and a small gear when you get done!
- 8. If you'd like an example here's the largest gear I created adhering all the pieces and parts to the largest gear with Liquid Glue
  - a) Largest Gear Copper Textured Metallic Specialty Paper
  - b) Open ring Earthen Toned Metallic Specialty Paper
  - c) Middle gear Earthen Toned Metallic Specialty Paper
  - d) Small middle gear Tungsten Textured Metallic Specialty Paper
  - e) Center (hub cap??) Earthen Toned Metallic Specialty Paper
  - f) Center Cross Tungsten Textured Metallic Specialty Paper



- 9. Use a ruler and the bullet end of the Light Secret Sea Stampin' Blend to draw two power cords for the lightbulbs.
- 10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the  $4" \times 5 \frac{1}{4}"$  piece of Secret Sea cardstock.
- 11. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the large layered gear.
- 12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere two of the die cut Smoky Slate gears tucking them underneath.
- 13. Use Liquid glue to adhere one of the florals from the Easter Time Mix & Match Ephemera Pack near the top.
- 14. Use scissors to trim off the bottom stem of the second **Easter Time Mix & Match Ephemera Pack** floral and then adhere it with Liquid Glue.
- 15. Use Stampin' Seal to adhere a loop of Cloud Cover 3/8" Faux Linen Ribbon.
- 16. On a piece of Smoky Slate cardstock stamp the large "birthday" from the **Reason to Celebrate** stamp set in Secret Sea ink.
- 17. Over the top, stamp "happy" in Secret Sea ink.
- 18. Use the banner die in the Stylish Shapes die set to cut it out.
- 19. Use Mini Black Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the ribbon.
- 20. Use Liquid Glue to tuck the final Gears & Textures gears around the sentiment.



- 21. Add seven **Pearlized Faceted Pearls** in white and Petal Pink.
- 22.In the center of the 4"  $\times$  5 1/4" piece of Basic White cardstock stamp the large "Special Day" from **Reason to Celebrate** in Secret Sea ink.
- 23. Over it stamp "on your" also in Secret Sea ink.
- 24. Stamp several images from the *Gears & Textures* set in stamped-off-once and stamped-off-twice Secret Sea ink.



- 25. Use Liquid Glue to adhere to the panel to the inside of the Smoky Slate card base.
- 26. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
- 27. Stamp the *Gears & Textures* images in stamped-off-once and stamped-off-twice Secret Sea ink on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
- 28. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
- 29. Lay the 2 1/4"  $\times$  6" piece of *Square Snippet DSP* to the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
- 30. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
- 31. DONE!
