

Stay Warm with Tweed and Pines Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Mossy Meadow Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

Cherry Cobbler Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front); 2 3/8" x 4 5/8" (mat for DSP panel on front)

Basic Beige Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)

Need for Tweed DSP: 4" x 5 1/4" (card front); Largest Stylish Shapes circle die cut (on card front); 2 1/4" x 4 1/2" (DSP panel on front); Stylish Shapes banner die cut(sentiment); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of **Need for Tweed DSP** on the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock.
2. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 2 1/4" x 4 1/2" piece on the 2 3/8" x 4 5/8" piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the card front.
4. Use the largest **Stylish Shapes** circle die to cut a circle from a piece of **Need for Tweed DSP**.
5. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the circle to the card front.
6. On a piece of the same design DSP stamp the argyle sweater from **Stay Warm** in Mossy Meadow ink.
7. Use scissors to fussy cut the sweater.
8. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sweater to the card front.
9. Tie a bow from two lengths of Early Espresso Linen Thread and adhere it with a Glue Dot.
10. Stamp the **Delicate Pines** sentiment in Cherry Cobbler ink on a piece of **Need for Tweed DSP**.
11. Use the **Stylish Shapes** banner die to cut out the sentiment.
12. Use double-stacked Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the bow. Note: on the right end, you'll need a THREE-stack of Dimensionals! :)
13. Use the Dark Mossy Meadow Stampin' Blend to color five clear dots from the **Ladybug Garden Epoxy Shapes**.
14. When the dots are dry adhere them to the card front.
15. In the corner of the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic Beige cardstock, stamp the heart image from **Stay Warm** in Mossy Meadow ink.



16. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Mossy Meadow card base.
17. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.

18. Stamp the **Stay Warm** heart on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
19. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
20. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **Need for Tweed DSP** to the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
21. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
22. DONE!
