

# Scalloped Wishes Sneak Peek Easel Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Pecan Pie Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" (card base, scored and folded at 4 1/4" then cut and scored as shown above)

Basic Beige Cardstock: 2 5/8" x 4 1/8" (inner liner under easel on front); 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" (back panel); Scalloped Wishes die cut frame & oval (sentiment on front); Scalloped Wishes die cut flowers (x5)

Mossy Meadow Cardstock: Scalloped Wishes die cut leaves


Old Olive Cardstock: Scalloped Wishes die cut leaves

Earthen Toned Metallic Specialty Paper: Scalloped Wishes die cut dragonfly body and wings

Delicate Dreams Specialty DSP: 2" x 2 5/8" (x2 - panels on easel); 2 5/8" x 4 1/8" (panel under sentiment on front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

## Instructions for this Project:

1. Score the 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece of Pecan Pie cardstock at 4 1/4" on the long side - just like a normal card.
2. Turn the card to place the short end at the top of the Paper Trimmer and cut down to the 4 1/4" score line.
3. Turn the cardstock again - placing the long edge up and - on the side with the cut-line - SCORE from the top down to the score line.



4. Fold the card at the 4 1/4" score line.
5. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the UN-scored side of the card base to the "back". Note: that's the panel on the right side - with the sentiment.
6. Fold the other panel into an easel.
7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 2 5/8" x 4 1/8" piece of **Delicate Dreams Specialty DSP** to the glued-down side of the card front.
8. On a piece of Basic Beige cardstock stamp the **Scalloped Wishes** sentiment in Mossy Meadow ink.
9. Use the smaller **Scalloped Wishes** frame die to cut out the sentiment.
10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the oval and the frame to the panel.
11. Use the dies in the set to cut out two small leaf boughs - one in Mossy Meadow and one in Old Olive.
12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the boughs to the oval.
13. Use the dies in the set to cut out a dragonfly wing and a body from **Earthen Toned Metallic Specialty Paper**.
14. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the body to the wing.
15. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the dragonfly to the sentiment oval.



16. Add three Secret Sea Muted Palette Dots to finish off that side of the card.
17. On the easel side, use Liquid Glue to adhere the two 2" x 2 5/8" pieces of **Delicate Dreams Specialty DSP** to each panel of the easel.
18. Use the small **Scalloped Wishes** frame die to cut out a Mossy Meadow frame.
19. Use Liquid Glue just on the bottom half of the die and adhere it to the "bottom" of the easel.
20. Use the **Scalloped Wishes** dies to cut out five Basic Beige small flowers, a large and a small Old Olive bough and a large and small Mossy Meadow bough.
21. Use scissors to snip the top off the large Mossy Meadow bough.
22. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the leaves on the side of the frame. Note: the Mossy Meadow bough pointing to the right is the snipped top from the large bough.
23. Use Liquid Glue to adhere a large and small Basic Beige flower with Liquid Glue.



24. Tie a small **Linen Thread** bow and adhere it with a dot of Liquid Glue.
25. Use a Mini Black Stampin' Dimensional to adhere another large die cut flower.
26. Add Secret Sea **Muted Palette Dots** to the flower middles.

27. On the 2 5/8" x 4 1/8" piece of Basic Beige cardstock stamped a **Scalloped Wishes** sentiment in Mossy Meadow ink.
28. Next to it, stamp the little dragonfly in Pecan Pie ink.
29. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel on the left side of the card base.



30. Use the **Scalloped Wishes** large leaf bough die to cut out THREE boughs.
31. Stack the die cuts up and adhere them together with Liquid Glue.
32. Use Mini Black Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere it in place on the left side of the card base as the easel stop.
33. Use the dies to cut out three small Old Olive die cut leaves.
34. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the small leaves and the remaining die cut flowers.
35. Add Secret Sea **Muted Palette Dots** to the flower centers.



36. On the 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" Basic Beige panel stamp the grass image from **Scalloped Wishes** twice in Mossy Meadow ink - without re-inking between stamps.
37. Stamp the **Scalloped Wishes** dragonfly in Pecan Pie ink.



38. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the back of the card base.
39. Stamp the grass image from **Scalloped Wishes** twice in Mossy Meadow ink - without re-inking between stamps on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
40. Stamp the **Scalloped Wishes** dragonfly in Pecan Pie ink.
41. Add a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
42. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **Delicate Dreams Specialty DSP** to the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
43. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
44. DONE!
