

Silly Sweet Friends & Sweet Words & Labels Sneak Peek Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Very Vanilla Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" (card base, scored and folded at 4 1/4"); 5/8" x 2" (sentiment)

Early Espresso Cardstock: Sweet Words & Labels die cut label (mat for DSP art); Sweet Old Friends die cut honey pot

Cajun Craze Cardstock: Sweet Old Friends die cut honey pot (x)

Golden Glow Cardstock: Sweet Old Friends die cut "honey" (x3)

Sweet Old Friends DSP: 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (card front panel); Sweet Words & Labels die cut art; ; 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" piece of **Silly Old Bear DSP** to the front of the Very Vanilla card base.
2. Use Liquid Glue to adhere a 2" wide strip of another pattern in the **Silly Old Bear** pack to the card front and trim the excess with scissors.
3. Use the die in the **Sweet Words & Labels** die set to cut out one of the vignettes in the **Silly Old Bear DSP**.
4. Use the next largest die in the set to cut out an Early Espresso cardstock label.
5. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the DSP label to the Early Espresso label.
6. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the whole thing to the card front.
7. On the 5/8" x 2" strip of Very Vanilla cardstock stamp the **Sweet Words & Labels** sentiment in Early Espresso ink.
8. Use Liquid Glue on the left end and a Stampin' Dimensional on the right end to adhere it to the card front.
9. Tie a small Linen Thread bow and adhere it with a little Liquid Glue.
10. Use the dies in the **Sweet Old Friends** die set to cut out three hunny pots - two from Cajun Craze cardstock and one from Early Espresso cardstock.
11. Use the "hunny" die in the set to cut out three from Golden Glow cardstock.
12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the "hunny" to the tops of the pots.
13. Use Liquid Glue and Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the hunny pots to the card front.
14. Use Mini Glue Dots to adhere three **Tiny Bee Trinkets**.
15. On the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock, stamp a sentiment from **Sweet Words & Labels** in Early Espresso ink.
16. In the corner stamp the image from **Sweet Old Friends** in Early Espresso ink.
17. Use the Light Golden Glow Stampin' Blend to color Pool.
18. Use the Dark Petal Pink and Dark Hydrangea Hue Stampin' Blends to color Piglet.



19. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the card base.

20. Stamp the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope with the *Sweet Old Friends* image in Early Espresso ink and color it as you did on the inside of the card.
21. Run a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
22. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of *Silly Old Bear DSP* to the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
23. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
24. DONE!
