

Stitched Frosted Pinecones Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Peaceful Pine Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base, scored and folded at 5 1/2")

Pecan Pie Cardstock: 4" x 5 1/4" (mat for card front); Frosted Pinecones die cut small pinecone

2026-2028 In Color Pearlized Paper:

Frosted Pinecones die cut pine boughs (x3 - in Peaceful Pine)

Basic Beige Cardstock: Stylish Shapes die cut banner (sentiment); Stamped and die cut large pine cone image; 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)

A Stitched Season DSP: 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (card front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)



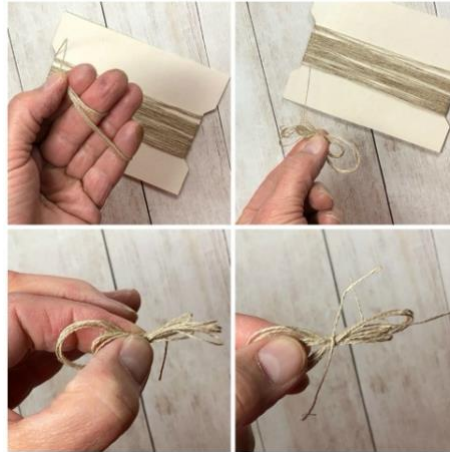
Instructions for this Project:

1. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of **A Stitched Season DSP** to the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Pecan Pie cardstock.
2. On a piece of Basic Beige cardstock stamp the large image from the **Frosted Pinecones** set in Peaceful Pine ink.
3. Secure the panel to your workspace using a temporary adhesive and then use the masks from the bundle - and **Small Blending Brushes** - to add color to the image:
 - a) Mask 1 - Pecan Pie
 - b) Mask 2 - Pecan Pie + a little Early Espresso
 - c) Mask 3 - Pecan Pie + a little Early Espresso
 - d) Mask 4 - Peaceful Pine
4. Use the 5th and final mask and a **Palette Knife** to add Shimmery White Embossing Paste (aka "snow") to the pinecone and pine needles.



5. Let the **Shimmery Embossing Paste** dry really well and then cut out the image with the large die from the **Frosted Pinecones** die set.
6. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the die cut to the card front.
7. Use the dies in the **Frosted Pinecones** set to cut out three pine boughs - 2 large and 1 small - from a piece of Peaceful Pine **2026-2028 In Color Pearlized Paper**.
8. Use a White Gel Pen to add "snow" to each of the pine needles.
9. Use the die in the set to cut out the small detailed pinecone from a piece of Pecan Pie cardstock.
10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut pinecone to the pinecone on the card front.
11. Tuck the three pine boughs in - using Liquid Glue to secure them.
12. Tie a double-loop **Linen Thread** bow
 - a) Wrap Linen Thread around four fingers four times.
 - b) Without cutting the thread, wrap around two fingers four times.
 - c) Pull the loops off and squeeze the loops together.
 - d) Twist the loops one time around to create a "figure 8".
 - e) Tie a second short length of Thread around the loops in the middle.

f) Spread the loops out to create a bow.



13. Use a scrunched up Mini Glue Dot to adhere the bow to the card front.
14. On a piece of Basic Beige cardstock stamp a **Frosted Pinecones** sentiment in Early Espresso ink.
15. Use a Stylish Shapes banner die to cut out the sentiment.



16. Use double-stacked Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the bow.
17. Add six clear snowflakes from the **Adhesive-backed Snowflakes**.
18. On the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic Beige cardstock, stamp a second **Frosted Pinecones** sentiment in Peaceful Pine ink.
19. In the corner, stamp the top of the large pinecone image in Peaceful Pine ink.
20. Use the masks from the bundle - and **Small Blending Brushes** - to add color to the image:
 - a) Mask 1 - Pecan Pie
 - b) Mask 2 - Pecan Pie + a little Early Espresso
 - c) Mask 3 - Pecan Pie + a little Early Espresso



21. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Peaceful Pine card base.
22. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
23. Stamp and use the masks to color the **Frosted Pinecones** image on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
24. Run a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.
25. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **A Stitched Season DSP** on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
26. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
27. DONE!
