

A Little Frosted Pinecones Hidden Slider Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Pecan Pie Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" (card base); 3 3/4" x 4 1/4" (slider, scored at 3/8" on the short side); Frosted Pinecones solid die cut pinecone

Cherry Cobbler Cardstock: 5 1/4" x 8 1/2" (card - scored at 2 3/4" and 6 3/4")

Autumn Woodland Glimmer Specialty Paper:

Frosted Pinecones detailed die cut pinecone (in Early Espresso)

2026-2028 In Color Pearlized Paper:

Frosted Pinecones die cut pine boughs (x4 - in Peaceful Pine)

Very Vanilla Cardstock: Next-to-Largest Tile Garden crimped-edge die (behind DSP square); 3/4" x 3 5/8" (front sentiment); 3 1/4" x 4 1/8" (inner sentiment panel on slider); 4" x 5 1/4" (back panel)

A Little Christmas DSP: 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" (striped - front panel); 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" (plaid - inside large panel); 1 5/8" x 5 1/8" (striped - front small panel); Next-to-Largest Tile Garden crimped-edge die (plaid DSP square on front); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Score the 5 1/4" x 8 1/2" piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock at 2 3/4" and 6 3/4".
2. Fold both score lines in - like a gate card.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" panel of striped **A Little Christmas DSP** to the larger front panel and the 1 7/8" x 5 1/8" piece of the same striped design to the front side of the smaller panel.
4. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" piece of plaid **A Little Christmas DSP** to the inside of the larger front panel.
5. Score the 3 3/4" x 4 1/4" piece of Pecan Pie cardstock at 3/8" on the short side.
6. Lay a strip of **Tear & Tape Adhesive** on the 3/8" section on the left side of the slider and put the slider in place inside the card.



7. Lay the larger front panel down - to adhere to the **Tear & Tape**. The video posted above will show you how this is done!
8. On the 3 1/4" x 4 1/8" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock, stamp a **Frosted Pinecones** sentiment in Cherry Cobbler - cheating it to the left side of the panel. Note: the video will show you how to determine where to stamp the sentiment!
9. In the corner, stamp part of the large **Frosted Pinecones** image in Peaceful Pine ink.
10. Color the pinecones with the Light and Dark Pecan Pie Stampin' Blends.
11. Brush the pinecones with the **Golden Glow Shimmer Brush**.



12. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the front of the slider.
13. Place **Tear & Tape** on the top edges of the inside of the opposite short panel.



14. Remove the cover from the Tear & Tape and close the right panel - "capturing" the slider. Again - the video is the best way to see how to do this!



15. Use the next-to-largest crimped-edge **Tile Garden** die to cut out a Very Vanilla square and a plaid **A Little Christmas DSP** square.

16. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the DSP square to the cardstock square.
17. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the square JUST to the left "gate" of the card front - being careful to center it on the card front and NOT get any adhesive on the smaller panel.
18. Use the dies for the smaller pinecones in the **Frosted Pinecones** die set to cut out a solid Pecan Pie pinecone and a detailed pine cone from Early Espresso **Autumn Woodland Specialty Glimmer Paper**.
19. Use the dies in the set to cut out two large and two small pine boughs from Peaceful Pine **2026-2028 In Color Pearlized Paper**.
20. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the detailed pinecone to the solid pinecone.
21. Use the completed pinecone as a guide and stamp a **Frosted Pinecones** sentiment in Cherry Cobbler ink on the left side of the 3/4" x 3 5/8" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock.
22. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the strip to the plaid square on the card front.



23. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the pine cone and the pine boughs.
24. At the bottom of the pine cone, use Liquid Glue to adhere a bow tied with two lengths of Linen Thread.
25. Add five Peaceful Pine **2026-2028 In Color Dots**.
26. Using Liquid Glue to adhere the completed card to the 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" piece of Pecan Pie cardstock.
27. On the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Very Vanilla cardstock stamp the large **Frosted Pinecones** image in Peaceful Pine ink.
28. Color the pinecones with the Light and Dark Pecan Pie Stampin' Blends.
29. Brush the pinecones with the **Golden Glow Shimmer Brush**.



30. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the back of the Pecan Pie card base.
31. Stamp and color the **Frosted Pinecones** image on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
32. Run a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flaps.
33. Lay a 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **A Little Christmas DSP** on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
34. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
35. DONE!
