

Alpine Winter Adventures Accordion Fun Fold Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Peaceful Pine Cardstock: 5 1/2" x 10 1/4" (accordion card base, scored and folded at 1 1/2", 3", 4 1/2" and 6"); 3 3/4" x 6" (small front card base, scored and folded at 3"); Winter Adventures die cut oval frame; 3" x 3 3/4" (mat for inside liner)

2026-2028 In Color Pearlized Paper:

Winter Adventures die cut trees (x3)

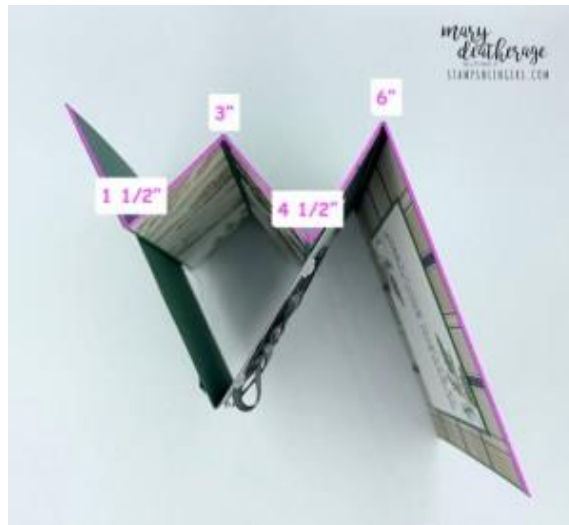
Misty Moonlight Cardstock: 1/2" x 3" (with angled end - sentiment); Winter Adventures die cut snowshoes (x2)

Basic White Cardstock: 2 7/8" x 3 5/8" (inside liner); 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" (back panel)

Alpine Winter DSP: 1 7/8" x 5 3/8" (x4 - accordion panels) card front); 2 7/8" x 3 5/8" (x2 - on small front card); 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" (back panel); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)

Instructions for this Project:

1. Score the 5 1/2" x 10 1/4" piece of Peaceful Pine cardstock at 1 1/2", 3", 4 1/2" and 6".
2. Starting with the 6" score - fold it as a valley and then fold each successive score line in the opposite direction to create an accordion.



3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" piece of plaid **Alpine Winter DSP** to the back panel.
4. Use Liquid glue to adhere the four 1 3/8" x 5 3/8" pieces of the DSP - in various designs - to the four small panels.
5. Stamp the pinecone image from the **Winter Adventures** set in Peaceful Pine ink in two corners of the 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" piece of Basic White cardstock.
6. Use the Light Pecan Pie Stampin' Blend to color the pinecones.
7. Use Liquid Glue to adhere it to the back of the card base.



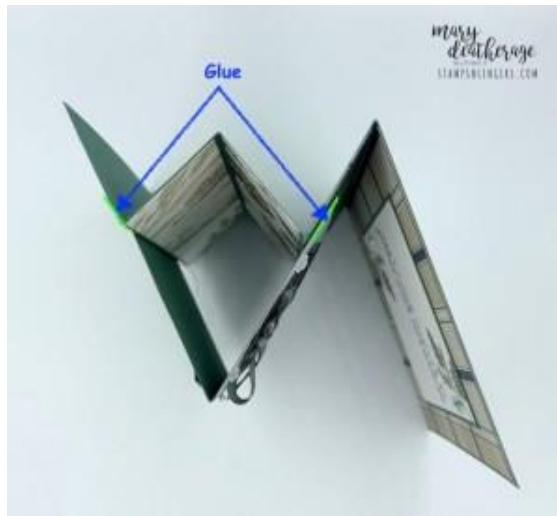
8. For the small card, score and fold the 3 3/4" x 6" piece of Peaceful Pine cardstock at 3".
9. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 2 7/8" x 3 5/8" piece of woodgrain **Alpine Winter DSP** to the front panel of the small card base. Note: remember this little card will open backwards - with the fold on the right (versus the left) so be sure to put the DSP on the correct "front".
10. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the 2 7/8" x 3 5/8" piece of mountain-y DSP to the other panel.
11. Use the oval frame die from **Winter Adventures** to cut out a Peaceful Pine frame.
12. Run the die cut (still in the die) back thru the Stampin' Cut and Emboss Machine using the **Impressions Plate** and the correct sandwich to emboss the die cut.
13. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the die cut to the wood-grain side of the small card front.
14. Use the same oval die to cut out a mountain-scape from the **Alpine Winter DSP**.
15. Keep the "negative" of the top portion and use Liquid Glue to adhere it in place inside the Peaceful Pine die cut.
16. Use the two tree dies in the **Winter Adventures** set to cut out three trees from Peaceful Pine **2026-2028 In Color Pearlized Paper**.
17. Use small bits of Black Stampin' Dimensional to adhere them to the oval.



18. Tie a bow from two lengths of **Linen Thread** and adhere it with a Glue Dot.
19. On the 1/2" x 3" piece of Misty Moonlight cardstock, stamp the sentiment from **Winter Adventures** in Versamark Ink.
20. Sprinkle it with white Basics WOW Embossing Powder and heat set it with the Heat Tool.
21. Use scissors to cut an angle in both ends of the strip.
22. Use Black Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere it over the bow.
23. Use the dies in the set to cut out two Misty Moonlight snowshoes.
24. Use Liquid Glue to adhere them to the other side of the small card.
25. Tie a small bow from **Secret Sea & Gold 3/8" Satin Ribbon** and adhere it with a Glue Dot.



26. Add three clear **Adhesive-backed Snowflakes** to both panels.
27. Close the large card base, center the small card on it and then use Liquid Glue to adhere it to the front accordion panel and then to the last accordion panel. Note: watch the video to see how to do it - it's a lot easier to show than to write.



28. On the 2 7/8" x 3 5/8" piece of Basic White cardstock stamp a second **Winter Adventures** sentiment in Misty Moonlight ink.
29. Stamp the pinecones in each corner in Peaceful Pine ink and color them with the Light Pecan Pie Stampin' Blend.
30. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the 3" x 3 3/4" piece of Peaceful Pine cardstock.
31. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the matted panel to the center of the back panel.
32. Stamp and color the **Winter Adventures** pinecones on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
33. Run a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.

34. Lay the 2 1/4" x 6" piece of plaid *Alpine Winter DSP* on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
35. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
36. DONE!
