

Arched Spotlight Frosted Pinecones Friendship Card

Card Stock Cuts for this Project:

Basic Beige Cardstock: 4 1/4" x 11" (card base - scored and folded at 5 1/2"); 4" x 5 1/4" (inner liner)

Pecan Pie Cardstock: 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" (mat for card front)

Wood Grain Wonders DSP: 4" x 5 1/4" (card front); Stylish Shapes die cut label (sentiment); 2 1/4" x 6" (envelope flap)



Instructions for this Project:

1. Stamp the large **Frosted Pinecones** image in Mossy Meadow ink in the corner of the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic Beige **Wood Grain Wonders DSP**.
2. Use the third-from-largest **Everyday Arches** die to cut from the middle of the panel.
3. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the outer portion of the panel to the 4 1/8" x 5 3/8" piece of Pecan Pie cardstock.
4. Temporarily secure the die cut to your work surface.
5. Use the first three masks of the **Frosted Pinecones** set and a Small Blending Brush to color the pinecone with Pecan Pie ink (for all three masks).
6. Use the 4th mask to lightly add Old Olive ink to the pine boughs.
7. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the completed arch back in place on the card front.
8. Tie a bow from a double-length of **Linen Thread** and adhere it with a Mini Glue Dot.
9. On another piece of the Basic Beige **Wood Grain Wonders DSP** stamp a **Thinking of You** sentiment in Early Espresso ink.
10. Cut it out with the **Three Banner Punch**.
11. Use double-stacked Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the sentiment over the bow.
12. Add three Mossy Meadow **Natural Matte Dots**.
13. On the 4" x 5 1/4" piece of Basic Beige cardstock stamp a second **Thinking of You** sentiment in Early Espresso ink.
14. Stamp the **Frosted Pinecones** image in the corner and color it with the masks.



15. Use Liquid Glue to adhere the panel to the inside of the Basic Beige card base.
16. Use Stampin' Dimensionals to adhere the card front to the front of the card base.
17. Stamp and color the **Frosted Pinecones** image on the front of the Basic White Medium Envelope.
18. Run a thin line of Liquid Glue around the edges of the envelope flap.

19. Lay a 2 1/4" x 6" piece of **Wood Grain Wonders DSP** on the flap and rub it lightly to ensure it's stuck down.
20. Use Paper Snips to trim off the excess paper.
21. DONE!
